## **What do you do?**

We support Vision Abolition, an Arizona-based non-profit organization that rescues and restores girls from the sex-trade and is building a village in Fiji as a safe-haven.

## **How do you do that?**

We sell cosmetics (all-natural, 100% vegan) and donate profits to Vision Abolition.

## **What does the money provide?**

100% of the donations go towards providing food, clothing, medical care, shelter, and training to girls who have been rescued from the sex trade.

Makeup, ironically, is often what these girls, sold into prostitution, use to prepare themselves for customers. We want to make that irony disappear in our lifetime by ending the sex trade.
